B ack in 1965, Louis Rogers and a lot of other wonderful folks were getting ready to set up an outdoor worship service on the Cranford's front yard. What they started we have carried on 56 years later.

This past year has been like no other, it has brought us great joy, accomplishment, and some sadness. We had to say goodbye for now to Terry Graydon, Deetsie Rogers, Gordon Brown, and Bob Wingenfield, but we will see them again in Heaven.

We could not meet in person and then our buildings got hit by a big tree and we had an indoor waterfall. It all was a little overwhelming. We had one of the last in-person worship services in the area then suddenly we got the word that there would be no more in-person worship until further notice. We scrambled to find out what to do next. I attended a zoom conference with preachers across the country, it was like a science fiction movie or the end of the world, it was depressing. How could we keep moving forward for God if were not meeting together?

Sunday was only days away and we had no ability to get our services online, it all seemed hopeless, but God is good. A couple of zoom conferences, a kind fellow associational church, and some tech advice from Dave Brown and hours before Sunday Morning we were up and running. There was never a Sunday when Blue Ridge didn't have a worship service. There was also a lot of texting, phone calls, and visiting from a distance. We went forward. We celebrated our graduates online, we welcomed back Janet Mann outside and safely distanced. We came back together safely and even had our Adult VBS together, we started our weekly devotionals "The Bentley Curonicles", we started having Bible

studies in person and online. We even safely had lunch together, and we had the best Fall Festival in the county (it was safe, drew a crowd, and was fun). we had our Christmas play, Candlelight and Carols, took care of our Christmas Families, and sent out a ton of Operation Christmas Shoeboxes. We made new friends, had visitors, got to see baptisms and dedicated babies. We celebrated Easter, had our community outdoor service, and had breakfast. On top of that through the hard work of Terry Graydon and a whole bunch of faithful members at Blue Ridge we put new roofs on all the buildings, put down new floors, put new paint on everything, put up new walls, remodeled bathrooms, refreshed the sanctuary, and more and more. I was cleaning up the other day and every room I passed through I came across things we had repaired, replaced, or refreshed, a lot of which I had forgotten.

The bottom line is that when the world falls apart what do you do? If you are a member of Blue Ridge Baptist Church then you just keep marching forward for the Kingdom of God. Terry Graydon's favorite verse was Romans 8:28, "And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose." The Old Testament counterpart of that verse is Genesis 50:20 "You intended to harm me, but God intended it for good to accomplish what is now being done, the saving of many lives." For those who faithfully serve Christ in the good times and the bad times God will be glorified, and Great days are coming!

Thank you all for your faithfulness, your friendship, and your love for Christ! God has great plans for Blue Ridge. We are prepared more than ever before for God to do mighty things among us including a real VBS in June. Our church is blessed with our church family whose children have accomplished great passages in their lives. We will celebrate these young people on Sunday, May 16 during Morning Worship.




